


Mobile Plays Developing Across All Payment Domains

POS: NFC-Enabled Phones Act as the Card

Good technology but a business model stand-off

NFC (Near Field Communications) chips communicate between applications on the phone and an NFC-enabled terminal Mobile






eCommerce: Bill-to-Mobile



Bill Pay: Presentment, Alerts, Payments

- Bill payment is common in mobile banking apps
- Bill presentment is possible though not yet common
- Presentment allows for mobile alerts, a potentially high value function on mobile devices


