Dafny is an applied microeconomist whose research focuses on competition in healthcare markets and the impact of public health insurance on healthcare costs and quality. Recent projects include “Are Private Health Insurance Markets Competitive?” and “Estimation and Identification of Merger Effects: An Application to Hospital Mergers”. Dafny graduated *summa cum laude* from Harvard College and earned her PhD in economics from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. She is a recipient of the National Science Foundation Graduate Research Fellowship, a Faculty Research Fellow of the National Bureau of Economic Research, and a Faculty Fellow of the Institute for Policy Research and the Center for the Study of Industrial Organization at Northwestern University. She has lectured to a variety of audiences, and has advised federal, state and local policymakers on healthcare and antitrust policy.
