Todd E. Elder has been an Assistant Professor of Economics and of Labor and Industrial Relations at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign since August 2001. He received his B.A. in economics from Stanford University and his Ph. D. in economics from Northwestern University. Current research projects include the effects of employer-provided health insurance on retirement; job loss, hours constraints, and labor market transitions of older workers; the incentive effects of welfare programs, especially SSI; the returns to Catholic schooling; and estimators for models of heterogeneous treatment effects in the presence of endogeneity.
