

Stephen A. Woodbury

Stephen A. Woodbury is a Professor of Economics at Michigan State University and a Senior Economist at the W.E. Upjohn Institute in Kalamazoo, Michigan. He was Deputy Director of the Advisory Council on Unemployment Compensation (U.S. Department of Labor) during 1993-94 and President of the Midwest Economics Association in 1998-99. He received his Ph.D. in Economics from the University of Wisconsin–Madison in 1981. Dr. Woodbury has worked mainly on issues in employee benefits and policies to assist unemployed workers. His books include *The Tax Treatment of Fringe Benefits* (co-authored with Wei-Jang Huang, 1991), *Reform of the Unemployment Insurance System* (co-edited with Laurie Bassi, 1998), and *Employee Benefits and Labor Markets in Canada and the United States* (co-edited with William Alpert, 2000).
