THEN

- Established over 120 years ago
- Upper, middle-class enclave

NOW

- Some well-tended homes & vibrant spaces
- Vacant homes vacancy rate of residential structures for census tract 5327 is approximately 56% and for census tract 5326 approximately 27% with some blocks having less than 10% occupancy
- Diversity of residents, some of whom have lived there for over 60 years
- Predominately African American (86%)
- Median annual household income is approximately \$26,000 | 37% below the poverty level
