

Arthur Wheaton is director of Western NY Labor and Environmental Programs for the Worker Institute at Cornell and Scheinman Institute on Conflict Resolution. His expertise includes industry education and workplace training, high performance work systems, negotiations, conflict resolution, as well as auto and aerospace industrial relations.
