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


We are going to need a bigger waiting room...

Because of Medicaid Expansion **2.7 Million low-income, uninsured individuals** who need substance use or mental health treatment are eligible for treatment.

Mental Health in America 2009 - 2013


Uninsured adults aged 18 to 64 who had **any behavioral health disorder** (mental illness or Substance Use Disorder) in the past year, by state expansion status.
